a base rate of twelve dollars (\$12.00) per hour be set for the Town Highway Department for all wingmen or other extra help in conjunction with snow removal, to be paid from the Highway Department, and that

the Highway Superintendent under Section 142, Subdivision 1(a) of the Highway Law, be authorized to purchase special tools and other implements required in the operation of the Highway Department, equipment not to exceed ten thousand (\$10,000) dollars for the year 2008, and twenty thousand (\$20,000.00) dollars for each public works project according to NYS and Town of Clifton Park procurement guidelines for the year 2008, and that

Employees of the Department of Building and Development are authorized to have memberships for the calendar year 2008 in the Capital District Chapter and the New York State Building Officials Conference to include attendance at regular bi-monthly luncheon meetings of said conference, as budgeted per person per year, said amounts to be charged to the Memberships/Training Account, and that

a Petty Cash Fund, not to exceed \$250 be established for use by the Town Supervisor, and that a Petty Cash Fund not to exceed \$250 be established for use by the Receiver of Taxes, and that

the mileage rate of reimbursement for the use of Town employees' cars shall be consistent with IRS established rates.

Regarding Joel Koval's proposed appointment to the Planning Board, Councilman Hughes read a prepared statement explaining residents have asked him to find balance that blends a healthy economy with environmental conservation and open space protection and that is why it is important to ensure that any new appointment to the Planning Board will subscribe to these same principals. He continued, the town has won one county and two statewide awards for smart growth and has saved over 850 acres of open space from development, created 13 miles of trails, expanded the parks and recreation program, hired the first open space coordinator in New York State and has dedicated surplus funds for a new park that will be twice the size of the Common. Additionally, \$300,000 has been invested in the open space fund for future land purchases. Councilman Hughes stated Mr. Koval is a capable individual with considerable experience on the Zoning Board and a record of community service and if this appointment was based solely on the individual, it would be an easy choice. However, given public sentiment and concerns about growth, a candidate with Mr. Koval's professional background as a local realtor may raise concerns among some residents. Councilman Hughes said he recognizes those concerns, is

sympathetic to them and will honor the pledges he has made, but he also recognizes that Mr. Koval's livelihood should not, on its own, disqualify him from voluntarily serving his community. Mr. Koval has been a valuable member of the Zoning Board and brings impressive experience on that front. He has asked Mr. Koval that, if appointed, he examine every application before the Planning Board with a careful eye, fair, balanced and impartial, exactly the same things that is asked of every appointee to each of the boards. He said Mr. Koval assured him of his intent to do so just as he has to date on the Zoning Board which is in keeping with the wishes and desires of the Town Board and the community. Councilman Hughes said this appointment, if confirmed, may have the advantage of actually increasing public awareness and participation in the work of the Planning Board. Councilman Hughes stated he will be voting in the affirmative.

Supervisor Barrett stated Mr. Koval has done a very good job as a member of the Zoning Board. The town is fortunate in having people with an interest in joining the Planning Board and the Town Board appreciates Mr. Koval's willingness to serve. The Supervisor said Mr. Koval's area of work in the private sector, along with the two appointments made last year of people who are involved in transportation matters throughout New York State, will add expertise to the Planning Board.

Councilwoman Walowit read a prepared statement that she is in agreement with Councilman Hughes and although she admires the candidate and the work he does within the community, she feels that his career of selling commercial real estate and sometimes becoming involved in the area of development has the potential of conflict. She stated she knows Mr. Koval is a gentleman of integrity but his familiarity with the groups that will come before him causes her to feel some sense of lack of propriety. She stated she regrets she cannot support the appointment but will vote in the affirmative for the organizational resolution.

Supervisor Barrett reviewed parts of the resolution, noting the Open Space, Trails, Riverfront Committee have staggered appointments. He thanked former Councilman Roy Speckhard for his work on establishing the Arts and Culture Commission and the appointments put forth this evening.
