

LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 2023, AMENDING CHAPTER 92, DOGS

§ 92-12 **Redemption; adoption; euthanization.**

D. The owner of animals impounded under this section, and pursuant to Article 7 of the Agriculture and markets law, which are injured or sick and which required veterinary care and impounding expenses shall be required to pay the veterinary and impounding expenses whether or not such owner chooses to redeem his or her dog.

§ 92-13 (b) The Animal Control office is authorized to Petition any court of competent jurisdiction for an order requiring the payment of veterinary or impoundment expenses in cases where animals are seized or impounded as a result of accident, injury, or illness under 1 NYCRR Section 77.2 et seq.

§ 92-15 **Penalties for offenses.**

E In addition to the penalties authorized by this section, the Town may seek, and a court of competent jurisdiction may impose, an order of restitution under this chapter for damages or destruction of property, or for veterinary bills directly related to an injury or damage to pets or domestic animals as a result of a violations of this chapter.

§92-21 In cases of Injured animals and pets seized under New York State Agriculture and Markets Rules and Regulations, 1 NYCRR Section 77.2 et seq. which required care and veterinary medicine due to injury or illness, the Animal Control Officer is authorized to seek restitution in an amount up to actual expenses incurred for such care at the Saratoga County Animal Shelter or similar facility.
